Our New Venue:

The situation at the Rodeway Inn became untenable, the prices went up precipitously and the service was not improving to meet those additional costs. The physical facility was not improving, the tables were not being replaced, the

rooms were still full of trash and there seemed to be no end to the makeshift arrangements required to put on a descent meeting. As a result the Council decided to sever the relationship with that establishment and look elsewhere for a more suitable venue. Directions to the NEW VENUE

It is easier to take the Northeast extension of the turnpike and get off at the Lansdale/Kulpsville exit. If you are going North you can take the slip ramp exit 31A and when you get off you make a right and then 1 block down you make a right into the Holiday Inn. If you don't have E-ZPass then take exit 31B and after you go through the toll plaza you will make a left at the light and go 1 block and make a right into the Holiday Inn. (See the map on page)

What do Carmelo Anthony, Bradley Cooper, Jay Z , Charlie Sheen , Brad Pitt and Leonardo DiCaprio have in common besides being famous Basketball players, Rappers and Movie Stars? They all collect watches.



Charlie Sheen was late to the Twitter party when he joined in 2011 during his crazy public onslaught that resulted in him getting canned from *Two and a Half Men*. After amassing 650,000 followers in less than 24 hours, Sheen **Tweeted out a picture** that caught the attention of watch lovers everywhere. Though Sheen was showing off Babe Ruth's 1927 World an auction, on his wrist was a \$700,000 Patek Philippe Re. 2438/1

watch, stealing the show. Sheen has amassed a huge collection of Patek Philippe watches and even "**misplaced**" a Patek Philippe Chronograph Perpetual Calendar 5970 watch estimated at \$175,000. No big deal, though, as the actor has plenty of them sitting around. Sheen's watch collection is reportedly worth \$5.6 million

One of Hollywood's leading men, Pitt is a brand ambassador for Tag Heuer, but his collection runs the gamut of luxury brands. Along with the obvious Tag Heuer pieces, the megastar has



also been seen wearing a \$23,000 Patek Philippe Nautilus and multiple Rolexes, including a GMT Master II, Submariner, and a Day Date. Pitt's wife, Angelina Jolie, is no slouch either. The bombshell actress has an impressive collection of her own and she even bought her husband a \$300,000 Patek Philippe Nautilus when the two were engaged—a Hollywood power couple to say the least.

NBA players like Kobe Bryant, Dwyane Wade, and LeBron James are all endorsed by luxury watch companies, but none are as invested as Carmelo Anthony. The New York Knicks forward, who is a partner of International Watch Collection (IWC), co-founded and launched HautTime, a print and online publication dedicated to luxury watches. Anthony recently

showed his insane collection that includes pieces from Audemars Piguet, Rolex, Hublot, IWC, and Patek Philippe in a video for Haute Time. While the Knicks continue to struggle on the court, 'Melo can find some solace in knowing that his collection is superior to those of his peers.



Bradley Cooper had his breakthrough moment in 2009 when *The Hangover* smashed box office records, and he has been one of Hollywood's biggest stars since. As his professional profile grows, so does his impressive watch collection. Cooper has been seen wearing an \$11,000 IWC watch, Rolexes, a Bulgari Octo Watch, Dior Homme, and more

One has only to listen to Hov's lyrics to get an idea of what kind of wristwear he has at home,



but that really just scratches the surface of his collection. He's been seen wearing a Richard Mille DLC tourbillon, a "cheap" (\$500) TW Steel watch, and a platinum Rolex Day Date II, amongst others. The rapper has also been generous with watch in 2011, it is rumored that he and Kanye West gave their sound engineers customized Rolex GMT Masters for not leaking the album.

A successful actor, global activist, and the face of Tag Heuer watches, Leonardo DiCaprio is a man of many hats. DiCaprio's collection of watches is just plain sick. From the classic Carrera 1887 Chronograph, to a limited edition Aquaracer, Leo has 'em all. His love for watches carries over on to



the big screen as well. In *The Wolf of Wall Street*, he sports a yellow gold Rolex GMT Master. In *Blood Diamond*, the actor wears a Breitling Chrono Avenger, and in *The Great Gatsby*, DiCaprio wears a classic Raymond Weil piece.


